

Pool Terms, Conditions Rules & Regulations (continued)

Guest Privilege: Guest tickets are available for \$5 per person/per day. Required advance payments are made at the SCC Pro Shop. Place tickets with guest's name in the blue guest ticket box on entering the pool area. Members must accompany guests when they are using the pool. Guest passes are for occasional visitors or to introduce potential new members to SCC. This is a privilege, not intended for repeat visitors or to avoid purchasing a pool membership. Any member abusing the guest privilege will be fined a minimum of \$25.

Pavilion Rentals: Reservation forms can be completed at the SCC Pro Shop. Up to 3 pavilions may be rented at \$50 each, by individuals with paid Pool memberships. The reservation must be made no less than 1 week in advance, so book early. Reserved units are rented for a period of up to 3 hours per day; with a maximum of 10 guests per unit. Renters must clean up after their gathering, using the refuse containers provided.

Weekly Family Memberships for Campers & Short Term Property Renters (i.e. Airbnb): Daily \$25, weekly \$75; includes all primary family members visiting in the same camper or ST rental home. Guests are \$5 each. See Guest Privilege.

Co-Ed Water Aerobics: Free classes: Mon-Sat 9:30 am to 10:30 am for pool members. Guests admitted for \$5 per day.

Bathing Suits: If you have been swimming in the lake, please wash your bathing suit before using the pool. Lake algae can contaminate the pool, causing algae growth.

Children: Children under 3 and those not fully potty trained are required to wear swim diapers. All children must be supervised when using the pool and restrooms.

Fecal Accidents: Accidents must be reported immediately to the Pro Shop. Accidents require immediate closure of both pools for treatment. Pools re-open approximately 24 hours after treatment.

Restrooms: Restrooms are located outside the pool area on the side of the clubhouse/restaurant building. It is imperative that all adults and children use the restrooms rather than the pool for urination. Please respect other swimmers.

Emergencies: An emergency 911 telephone is located on the pool pump house. The phone automatically dials 911 when the receiver is picked up. For emergencies ONLY.

First Aid: A kit is mounted on the wall outside the pool pump house.

General Pool Rules (Failure to follow all the SCC pool rules and regulations stated herein will result in cancellation of membership with **NO** refund of paid membership fees).

Pool members & paid guests **ONLY**, others are trespassing. Contact the Pro Shop or Sheriff to report trespassers.

Sign in with your name, membership number, & number of family members each time you use the pool. See Guest Privilege section for guest information.

No animals/pets are allowed in the pool or pool area.

Pool members must be 18 years/older to buy pool guest tickets. Pool members are fully responsible and liable for the conduct of all family members and guests.

All children must be supervised by individuals 16 years/older in the pool, pool area and restrooms. Children under 6 must be accompanied in the water by adult supervision at all times.

The cost of ANY damages to the property or equipment by a member or their guest(s), will be billed to the pool member.

Running, boisterous/rough play, fence climbing or throwing objects (except soft sponge balls) is not allowed.

Playing/using floats is allowed as long as users are courteous and careful to allow swimmers to swim.

No hanging, playing or standing on the safety rope/floats at the deep end of the pool.

No swimming under, hanging onto or playing on pool ladders.

Clean up after yourself/guests, picking up dropped food, etc., using provided trash receptacles. Please lower your umbrella when leaving.

No glass, food or drink(s) allowed in the pool. No glass is allowed on the pool deck.

No swimming solo, a swim buddy is needed, as no lifeguard is on duty.

No one under the influence of alcohol/drugs may use the pool.

No spitting or nose blowing in the pool.

No one with a diarrheal illness, nausea, skin, eye, ear or respiratory infection or open lesions/wounds should enter the pool.

Please call the Pro Shop if you see anyone breaking SCC's rules.

About Stone Creek Cove

This great community is located on the shores of beautiful Lake Hartwell. The lake is a US Corps of Engineers managed lake having 962 miles of shoreline spanning two states, South Carolina and Georgia. The community boasts custom single family homes, a number of available buildable lots and three condominium complexes with 44 condo units. The complexes (Providence Villas, Shelter Point and Springfield Villas) each have community docks. All SCC residents, living in the same household, enjoy the use of both the golf course & pool. Walking golf greens fees and pool memberships are included in the HOA dues for each person living in a SCC developed, residential household (homeowners in good standing).

Paid **non-resident memberships** are available for both the Pool and Golf Course. Discounts are offered when combining a pool & golf memberships.

About the Stone Creek Cove Golf Course

Built in 1971, the course is a challenging 9-hole course with 5 sets of tees (men 2; women 2; and seniors 1) to maximize each round when playing 18 holes. The course is semi-private, being **OPEN TO THE PUBLIC** & SCC residents; with non-resident memberships available. Playing 18 holes from the men's tees, the course is a Par 70, measuring 5,279 yards. Designed to challenge avid golfers, the course is also a great place to learn to play golf. Owned/managed by the Stone Creek Cove Homeowners Association, the HOA is committed to proper fertilization & maintenance of the course, for the best possible playing conditions.

About the Stone Creek Cove Swimming Pool

One of the largest swimming pools in the Upstate, SCC's pool is typically open from Memorial Day to Labor Day. While the pool is an amenity for SCC Residents (in good standing) SCC offers well priced non-resident memberships each season. Rates are discounted when coupled with a Golf Membership. Owned/managed by the SCC Homeowners Association, upgrades in recent years have made this pool the area's premier amenity/facility.

SCC Golf Course Rules and Regulations

- * Soft spikes are required, hard spikes NOT PERMITTED.
- * The SCC recommended dress code is outlined below. Appropriate attire is expected at all times
- * Every player is to check in/sign in at the Pro Shop each time they access the course.
- * All rounds start on the #1 tee, unless otherwise instructed by Pro Shop staff.
- * Each player must have a set of golf clubs in a golf bag. Sharing equipment is not allowed.
- * Please keep carts on paths, where posted. Keep carts behind Blue stakes & avoid driving carts through wet areas. Pull carts should be kept 20 feet away from greens and tees. Every golf cart operator must have a valid State issued driver's license. Unlicensed individuals/children may not operate a golf cart on the SCC Cove Golf Course at any time. Carts must **ALWAYS** be driven slowly at a **SAFE** speed for conditions. Unsafe, careless, reckless operation is not allowed.
- * Cart usage – 2 per foursome and 1 per twosome, ONLY.
- * Fivesomes are only allowed at the discretion of and approval by staff at the Pro Shop.
- * Use courtesy and always allow faster players to "Play Through".
- * Repair all ball marks on greens and divots on fairways.
- * If there is lightening in the area, all play must cease. SCC Golf Course assumes NO liability for lightening related accidents.
- * Please use provided trash containers for all trash (or keep it in the cart). Pick up any trash accidentally left by others. Help us keep the course clean!

NOTE: Non-resident golf memberships are available for 6 or 12 consecutive months periods. A signed billing agreement is required (available at the Pro Shop).

SCC Golf Course Basic Dress Code

Men: Neat, collared shirts with sleeves and no fraying/holes/tears. Pants & shorts to be fitted at the waist, neat, tailored with no fraying/holes/tears.

Women: Neat shirts with sleeves; sleeveless shirts with wide enough shoulder straps to be suitable for golf. Shirts must cover the midriff. No fraying/holes/tears. Pants & shorts are to be an appropriate length, Neat and tailored with no fraying/holes/tears.

Inappropriate, not permitted apparel:

- Shirts - tank tops; t-shirts/undershirts; shirts with printed slogans or pictures; tube tops; halter tops; swimwear.
- Pants - cutoffs; pants or shorts that are: jogging, baggy, low slung, drawstrings or swimwear.

Dates of Operation - typically from Memorial Day to Labor Day (check FB, Pro Shop or website).

Hours of Operation - Sunday thru Saturday, 10:30 a.m. to dusk.

Weather/Storm - if any thunder or lightening is in the area, the pool will be closed. The National Lightning & Safety Institute recommends when thunder/lightening is in an area, pools & outdoor decks be cleared until 30 minutes have passed since the last clap of thunder.

Pool Usage Sign-In – When entering the pool, residents and non-resident members must sign in. A sign-in sheet is located in a metal box inside the pool area, to the right of the front entrance gate. Users must list their member number, name, time and number of household members attending. If hosting guests, guest pass(es) for them must be purchased in advance at the Pro Shop, before signing in. The guest ticket holder's name must be listed on the guest ticket. When signing in, the guest ticket should be placed in the blue guest ticket box.
